### **Cannot Run Cognos Report due to Security Privileges in Maximo**

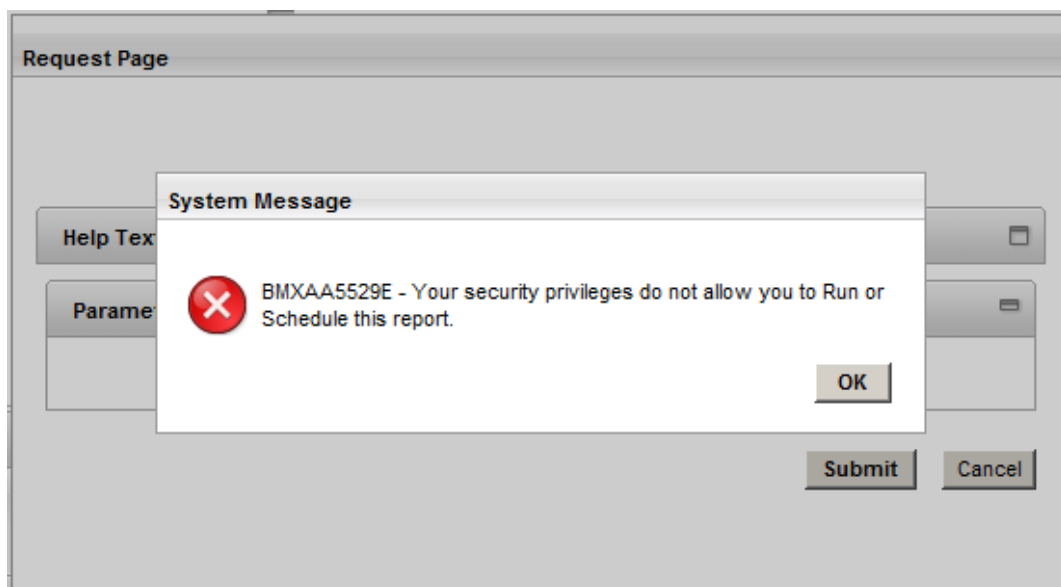

Prerequisites and Assumptions:

- Ensure Maximo is Installed and running
- Ensure Cognos is installed and running
- Ensure that you can Launch Cognos Administration from within Maximo
- Ensure that the report you are trying to run in Maximo has been created and has the correct attributes set.

You have created a Cognos report in Maximo. When you click Preview to run the report the following error is displayed:

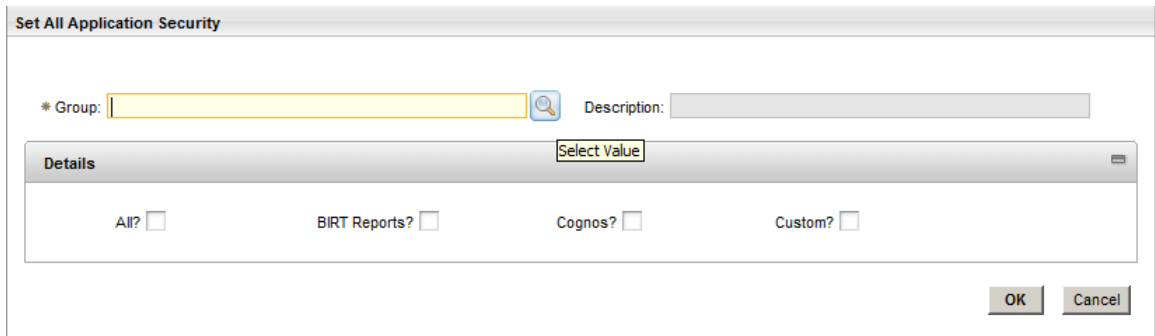
**Figure 1 – Maximo Security Error**



The following steps will show you how to assign security to allow the user to run Cognos reports from within Maximo:

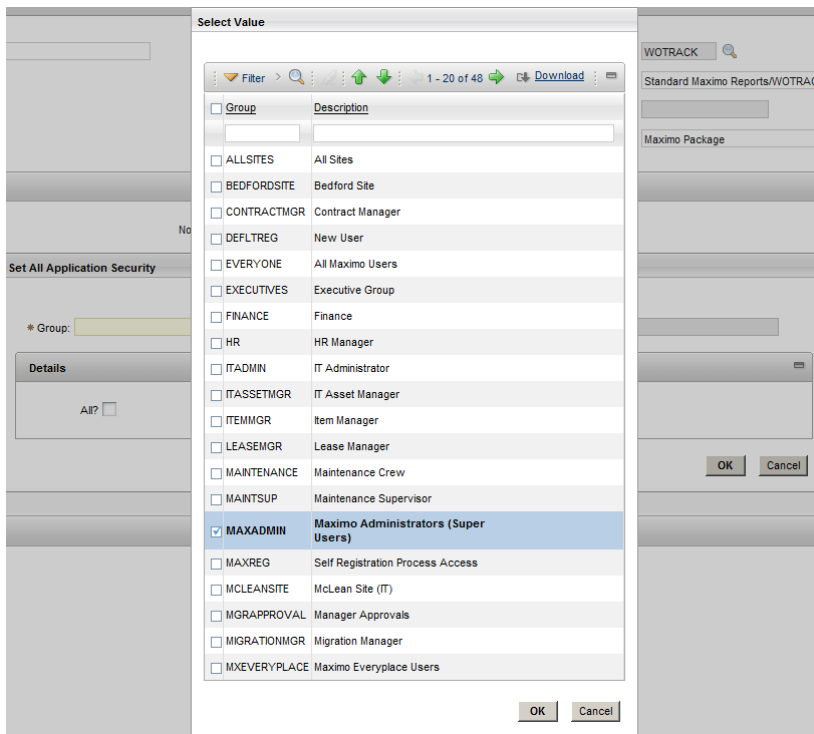
1. Navigate to the report Administration screen. Go To > Administration > Reporting > Report Administration
2. From the Select Action drop down menu select Set All Application Security.
3. Click the Select Value button next to Group:

**Figure 2 – Set All Application Security Screen**



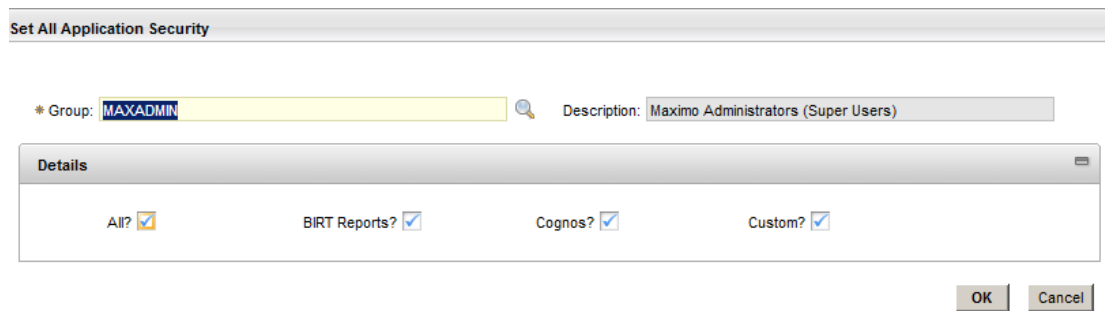
4. Check the box next to select the user that you want to run the report as. In the example below I want MAXADMIN to be able to run Cognos reports:

5. Click Ok
6. Check the All? Checkbox to allow the user to be able to run all report types:

7. Click Ok
8. Search for a Cognos report, ensure that the request page has been generated if it hasn't already and then click Preview.
9. Click Submit
10. A new Window will open displaying the results of the Cognos report:
